# North/South Alumni & Friends Regatta

*The UCSB Sailing Team Alumni are pleased to invite you to the North-South Alumni & Friends Invitational Regatta. The goal of the event is to reunite our alumni and friends of the program together to celebrate the friendships they have cultivated over the years, as well make new friends with other generations of UCSB Sailing supporters. The event benefits the UCSB Sailing Team and their goal of approximately \$9000 towards their operational budget.*

## 1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 The US Sailing prescriptions to rules 63.2 will not apply.

## 2. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY, & CLASSES

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all alumni and friends of UCSB Sailing.
- 2.2 Competitors may enter by filling completing an online entry form and paying applicable fees. A link to online entry may be found online at:

- 2.3 Invited classes to be sailed include:
  - a.) **FJ's** - open to all alumni and friends of UCSB Sailing. Boats and sails are provided free of charge on a first come – first serve basis and should be reserved through the registration process. No current student shall be at the helm and current students shall not sail as crews unless there are boats left unfilled the day of the regatta.
  - b.) **Melges 24** - Melges 24 teams shall include at least three UCSB Alumni and must have a UCSB Alumni at the helm. Exceptions to these rules may be made at the discretion of the event chairs & race committee. Participants interested in entering a Melges 24 team in the regatta and requests for boats should be made to Brad Schaupeter by emailing [racing@sbyc.org](mailto:racing@sbyc.org).
  - c.) **RS Quests** - open to graduates of the JV Sailing Team. Boats and sails are provided free of charge on a first come – first serve basis and should be reserved through the registration process.
  - d.) **Additional Classes** - Any other class interested in being included in the regatta must contact the SBYC Race Director at [racing@sbyc.org](mailto:racing@sbyc.org) at least one week prior to the regatta.
  - e.) **Spectator** – Participants who do not wish to race are encouraged to attend and go out on a spectator boat or to simply enjoy a day at the beach in beautiful Santa Barbara, California.

## 3. FEES

- 3.1 There is no mandated entry fee, however this event is a fundraiser for the UCSB Sailing Team. Suggested minimum donations are listed below (but please consider giving more if you are in that fortunate position).
  - 3.1.1 Class of 2022-2023: Suggested minimum donation of \$75
  - 3.1.2 Class of 2020-2021: Suggested minimum donation of \$125
  - 3.1.3 Class of 2018-2019: Suggested minimum donation of \$250
  - 3.1.4 Class of 2017 and earlier: Suggested donation of \$300
- 3.2 Applicable parking fees will apply. Santa Barbara Harbor lot is \$10 per day.

#### 5. RISK STATEMENT

RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform, and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**
